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## Oaklands Wetland and Stormwater Reuse Scheme

**Project value:** \$9M

**Client:** City of Marion

**Date:** 2012-2013

FMG Engineering project managed the design and construction of the wetland and associated ASR system designed to harvest and store wetland treated stormwater and to distribute the recovered water, via an aquifer, for irrigation purposes at around 30 council reserves. Works included construction of three pedestrian foot bridges, a wetland, a grated intake structure in the Sturt River and the landscape design of the park. Works also included installation of a gross pollutant trap, an 8m in-ground pumping station and a wetland drainage system.

## Bowden Urban Village
